Scholarship award criteria:

1. Applicants must have a “B” average as shown on their high school transcript.
2. Applicants must have demonstrated leadership in school and/or community involvement.
3. Applicants must have applied for or been accepted for enrollment in an accredited college or university and working toward a bachelor’s or associate degree; or enrolled in a vocational-technical institution which leads to a certificate.
4. Financial need of the applicant may be considered in the scholarship award.
5. All applicants must be children, stepchildren, grandchildren, great grandchildren, nieces, or nephews. who are related to a Primary REALTOR® Member of the Metro South Association of REALTORS® and are graduating from an accredited high school program within the state of Georgia.
6. The applicant’s high school principal and school counselor must sign each application to verify the student’s scholarship, character, and extracurricular activities.
7. Recipients of the scholarship must register for and complete the minimum number of hours required to be classified as a full-time student at the institution of their choice and maintain a cumulative “C” average.
